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Lung Cancer Screening Saves Lives

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Breathe Easier, Have Peace of Mind

Lung Cancer is the number 1 cause of cancer related deaths in the United States. Early detection saves lives.

What is a Lung Cancer Screening?

Lung cancer can be detected early through a low dose CT scan without using contrast. The CT scan uses x-ray to scan the entire chest in about five to ten seconds during a single breath hold. The entire examine is completed in about 15 minutes.

If a tumor is found while it is small there is a better chance that it can be removed. CT scans aid in finding lung cancer in their earliest stage when up to 90% can be cured.
